

## **Choosing a Diaper Bag**

### **4) Diaper Bag Features**

Diaper bags can offer features such as bottle holders, elastic straps, mesh pockets and pockets for just about everything. Diaper bags must also be fully padded thus insulated from heat and cold.

If you plan to haul your own items as well as baby's, look for a diaper bag that features key clips, cell phone pockets and parent organizers that fit your needs. It will be helpful that the diaper bag have 2 major compartments, 1 for the baby and 1 for mummy. Therefore, this diaper bag acts not only as a baby bag but also as a bag to carry your essential such as keys, purse, mobile phone, cosmetic accessories & etc. Consequently, you carry around one less item.

Having a diaper bag that can stand up by itself is important. This feature allows you to set the bag down and search for something all while holding onto your child.

## 5) Diaper Bag Closures

Diaper bags are available with zipper tops, fold-over tops and snap or tie closures and more. Think about when and where you'll be using the diaper bag, and whether you will often need to reach inside the bag quickly. If so, a snap closure may be more convenient. If security issues or over-turned diaper bags are likely, a zipper top would be more appropriate. Be sure you can work the diaper bag closure easily, and remember that you may be opening or closing it while wrangling a messy baby.

## 6) Diaper Bag Size and Fabric

Selecting the size and fabric of a diaper bag is similar to that of picking a new purse. After all, you will be using it daily and really need to like it. Before you fall in love with a diaper bag in an exotic fabric, consider the abuse that diaper bags must take in a few short years. Look for a fabric that is easily spot-cleaned or can be wiped clean. Vinyl or faux leather diaper bags can be fashionable and easy to wipe down, or, if you prefer the look of a fabric diaper bags, look for a bag that has a clear plastic protective layer over the fabric to keep your diaper bag looking great through diaper changes and other baby messes.

Diaper bag which is waterproof or water resistant material is highly recommended. Diaper bag would be set down on a wide variety of surfaces and exposed to every sort of weather possible, so durability and clean ability are important.

It's tempting to buy the biggest diaper bag in hopes of stashing an entire portable nursery inside. Remember that the more non-essentials you carry, the more strain on your shoulders. If you tend to over-pack or let things accumulate in your bag, consider buying a diaper bag just big enough for diaper change basics, so you won't end up with a bulging diaper bag and a sore back.
